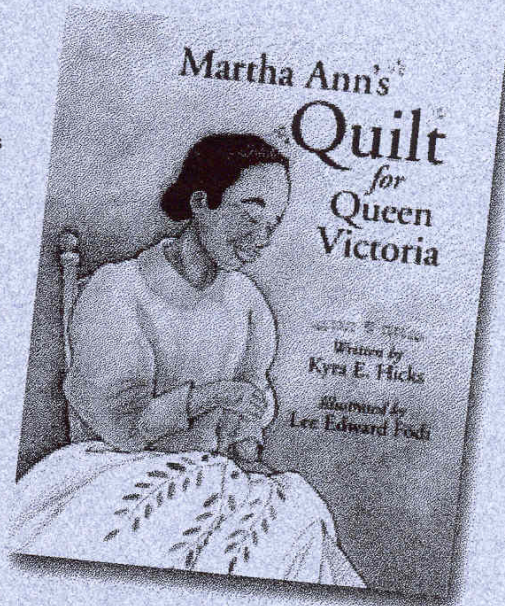
Martha Ann's Quilt for Queen Victoria
